Cost £20 per head.

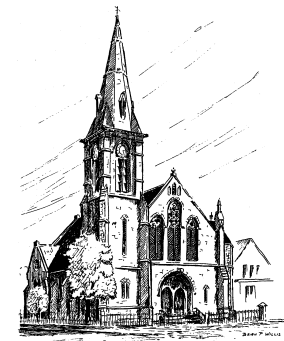
